1. Information We Collect

We may collect the following types of information:

- **Personal Information:** If you subscribe, contact us, or leave a comment, we may collect your name, email address, and any information you voluntarily provide. We do not request sensitive information such as passwords, payment details, or government identification numbers. Please do not submit sensitive information through our contact forms or comments.

- **Children's Privacy:** This website is not directed to individuals under the age of 16, and we do not knowingly collect personal information from children under the age of 16. 2. How We Use Your Information

We use the information we collect to:

3. How We Share Your Information

These providers process information solely for the limited purpose of providing services to us and are subject to contractual restrictions on the use of that information.

4. Cookies, Analytics & Website Tracking

Cookies: We use cookies to enhance your browsing experience, and analyze our traffic. When you visit our website, a cookie consent banner allows you to customize your preferences across the following categories:

- **Necessary** - Required for basic site functionality. Always active and cannot be disabled.
- **Analytics** - Helps us understand how visitors interact with our site (e.g., page views, traffic sources). We use Google Analytics for this purpose.

Non-essential cookies (Functional, and Analytics) are only activated after you provide consent through our cookie consent banner. You may update your preferences at any time by accessing the consent tool on our website. You may also adjust your browser settings to refuse cookies; however, some features of the site may not function properly.

Analytics: We use Google Analytics to collect aggregated, non-personal usage data. We do not use session replay, keystroke logging, chat recording, or other technologies that record or intercept user communications on our website.

Do Not Track Signals: Some browsers offer a "Do Not Track" feature. At this time, our website does not respond to Do Not Track signals. However, you may control tracking through your browser settings and the cookie consent tool available on our site.

Data Retention: Google Analytics retains aggregated usage data in accordance with Google's data retention settings, which we have configured to the minimum period necessary. We do not maintain a separate internal database of user personal information beyond what you voluntarily submit through contact forms or opt-in subscriptions, which is retained only as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes described in this policy.
